



Ioana Agache, MD PhD

Ioana Agache is professor of allergy and clinical immunology at Transylvania University in Braşov, Romania. She is a past president of the European Academy of Allergy and Clinical Immunology (EAACI; 2017-2019) and is the chair of EAACI's Research and Outreach Committee.

Her research in the field of asthma, allergy, and clinical immunology focuses on asthma phenotypes and endotypes, immune modulation and immune tolerance, and the role of the exposome and One Health in allergic diseases and asthma.

Dr. Agache coordinated the EAACI Guidelines on biologicals and the EAACI Guidelines on Allergen Immunotherapy (AIT) in Asthma and is leading the EAACI Guidelines on Allergic Asthma, the EAACI Guidelines on the Environmental Science in Allergy and Asthma, and the EAACI Task Force on New Nomenclature for Allergic Diseases.

She is editor of several books, including *Implementing Precision Medicine in Best Practices of Chronic Airway Diseases* (2018), *Global Atlas of Asthma* (2013 and 2022), *Global Atlas of Allergy* (2014), and *Global Atlas of Allergic Rhinitis and Chronic Rhinosinusitis* (2015). She is deputy editor of *Allergy* and associate editor of *Clinical and Translational Allergy*.

Dr. Agache graduated with a medical degree from Carol Davila University of Medicine and Pharmacy in Bucharest, Romania, and graduated magna cum laude when she earned her PhD in internal medicine.
