Dr. Gooderham is a dermatologist and medical director at the SKiN Centre for Dermatology in Peterborough, ON, Canada; an investigator with Probitry Medical Research; an assistant professor at Queens University; and a consultant physician at the Peterborough Regional Health Centre.
