

Akimichi Morita, MD PhD Nagoya, Japan

Akimichi Morita is professor and chair of the Department of Geriatric and Environmental Dermatology at Nagoya City University Graduate School of Medical Sciences and vice director of Nagoya City University Hospital in Nagoya, Japan. His main

research interests are photobiology, phototherapy, cutaneous immunology, skin aging, and psoriasis. He has introduced numerous standard phototherapies to Japan.

Dr. Morita is the president of the Japanese Society for Psoriasis Research (2022-present) and previously served as president of the Japanese Society for Photomedicine and Photobiology (2018-2022) and president of the Japanese Society for Investigative Dermatology (JSID; 2018-2020). He is an editorial board member of several prestigious medical journals and editor-in-chief of Experimental Dermatology. He has served as editor-in-chief of Photodermatology, Photomedicine & Photoimmunology (2018-2021) and Journal of Dermatological Science (2008-2013). He has published over 200 articles in peer-reviewed journals and written 26 books or book chapters.

Dr. Morita graduated from Nagoya City University and received his MD in 1989. He received his PhD in basic immunology from Aichi Cancer Center in Nagoya. As a Humboldt Foundation Fellow, he studied photobiology and photoimmunology at Düsseldorf University in Düsseldorf, Germany. He underwent further training at the University of Texas Southwestern Medical Center in Dallas, Texas, USA.
