JiaDe (Jeff) Yu is the director of occupational and contact dermatitis and runs a dedicated atopic dermatitis clinic at the Massachusetts General Hospital and Harvard Medical School in Boston, MA, USA.

His clinical interests include eczema, complex inherited genetic skin conditions (genodermatoses), and the full spectrum of pediatric dermatology.

He is the president-elect of the American Contact Dermatitis Society and serves on the Society's Pediatric Contact Dermatitis Working Group and the Interactive Media Committee. He also is an active member of the IEC, the Society of Pediatric Dermatology, Pediatric Dermatology Research Alliance, and the American Academy of Dermatology. He has published multiple peer-reviewed journal articles in Pediatric Dermatology, Dermatitis, Pediatrics, American Journal of Dermatopathology, Journal of Cutaneous Pathology, Journal of Pediatrics, and Journal of Child Neurology.

Dr. Yu received his medical degree from the University of Virginia where he was inducted into the Alpha Omega Alpha medical honor society. He completed a pediatrics internship at the Massachusetts General Hospital for Children, his dermatology residency at the Medical College of Wisconsin where he served as chief resident, and his pediatric dermatology fellowship at the Children's Hospital of Philadelphia/University of Pennsylvania.
